Q: Who can go to the Boundary Waters?

<u>A:</u>

- **High School** (completed 9th grade as of June 2021 through completed 12th grade as of June 2021)
- College Students & Young Adults

Q: What is a canoe trip?

<u>A:</u> Wilderness canoe trips are long standing St. Paul tradition! It is an incredible opportunity to explore the beauty and serenity of God's creation, strengthen faith, and come away with a better understanding of how precious this world is. With the direction of your WCB guide, you will spend a week paddling, portaging, and camping throughout the Boundary Waters while building deeper relationships with those on your trip.

Q: How much will the trip cost?

<u>A</u>: The trip is \$485 per a person. We are hoping this cost can be reduced through participation in fundraisers. We are trying to be creative in implementing some socially distanced fund raisers. A \$100 Deposit by March 8, 2021 will hold your spot

Q: What are the dates for the trip

<u>A</u>: July 10-17, 2021 are the dates for the trip, including travel and nights canoeing. Travel will be by car or van.
