In some ways I would use the same words to describe the church, as a body of people always in a process of constant flux, being built up and renewed daily. What excites me most in this season of change, is to know that we do it together as a community, particularly as a community with a vision. A vision for an unpredictable future. A vision for the work of the church at a moment when so many find it to be inconvenient. A vision that jars us beyond what we see in our daily lives into the realm of God's divine love. That's what I see and hear, and I wouldn't trade it for the world.

COVID Phase 5 Update

Illinois has entered into "Phase 5", which puts before us new opportunities to gather, even in the midst of a major construction project. Our Church Council, at the recommendation of the Health and Safety Task Force, and in consultation with CDC guidelines, has approved a plan for our continued reopening. The following changes are now in effect:

Registration is no longer required for services.

Masks are no longer required for all fully vaccinated persons, however we ask that all non-fully vaccinated individuals still wear a mask. Masks continue to be required when entering any space shared with our Day Care, including our shared hallway and restroom.

Our worship liturgy will continue to gradually expand to include more communal participation. At this time, limited speaking, singing, and movement are allowed, with further adjustments occurring gradually over time.






Book Club July 12, 6:45 pm
